
Women Leaders Unite for Climate Ambition and the Phase Out of Fossil Fuels

3rd December 2023 | Geneva, Switzerland: SHE Changes Climate convened the Unite For Climate Solutions virtual, day-long summit on 21 November 2023 in partnership with Project Dandelion and partners, including The Elders where former president of Ireland, Mary Robinson, sits as chair.

The day-long online summit brought together recommendations for united action from more than 30 women leaders across five continents. Which was shared during the discussion with the COP28 High Level Champion H.E. Razan Al Mubarak and UAE Chief Climate Negotiator Hana Al Hashimi.

The summit was a major event demonstrating the power of women leaders uniting for climate ambition, including the phase out of fossil fuels, the importance of nature based solutions, climate finance and the principles of inclusion and diversity at all levels of decision making.

30 outstanding women leaders were joined by 800 participants from around the world, with 12.9 million views through social media. As an organisation guided by solutions and the urgent need for equitable climate action, we stand firm in our support for women driving positive change.

We continue our work in support of COP28 High Level Champion H.E. Razan Al Mubarak and UAE Chief Climate Negotiator Hana Al Hashimi.

Now more than ever, we must ask collectively for a COP28 decision on the phase out of fossil fuels to stay in line with climate science and stay below the 1.5 degree target set in Paris. We are urgently asking the EU, the USA and China to position themselves for the phase out of fossil fuels and join the efforts of the high ambition coalition, AOSIS and New Zealand. The world is already at 1.4 degrees and there is no time to lose.
